## 1. Annual 4th of July Parade & Festivities: Sunday, July 4th 2021

After the artist awards announcements at 1:30, brother-led acoustic folk musicians Trapper Schoepp will take the stage. Perennial favorites Yata, Sinz, & Orfield will close out the festival with their soulful vocals, guitar, and saxophone.
